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What is the Saturday Family Workshop?

The Saturday Family Workshop (SFW) is a school-based intervention model with a helping perspective for families dealing with school, community and other substance abuse issues. It is a service provided by the Six District Educational Compact schools at no charge.

This workshop is offered to students in grades 9-12 and their parents or legal guardians as an alternative consequence of a school policy violation or a juvenile justice referral.

Focused on the family, attendance of the student and at least one parent or legal guardian is required. In addition, any family can elect to participate in the Saturday Family Workshop solely to increase their own education and awareness.

The workshop is designed with an educational format to teach substance abuse awareness. Instructional methods include short lectures, videos, and large and small group discussions in an informal setting. Instructors have extensive training in the area of substance abuse education.

Participation is required at three sessions on consecutive Saturday mornings.

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Workshop Features

- The Saturday Family Workshop High School is provided free of charge to students in grades 9-12 who attend a Six District Educational Compact school. A fee may be required for students from Non-Compact school districts.
- Emphasis on the family means the participation of at least one parent or legal guardian is required.
- The program follows an educational format, rather than providing counseling or therapy.
- Instructors have extensive training in the area of substance abuse education.
- Teaching methods include short lectures and videos. Sessions are conducted in an informal setting that encourages large and small group discussion.
