Key to Terms:

ASSESSMENT An opportunity to meet one-on-one with an alcohol and drug specialist who will evaluate the nature of the problem/issue a student is having with alcohol or drugs. If determined necessary or appropriate, the counselor can make recommendations for further treatment. During an assessment a student is involved in discussing biological, physiological, and social factors affecting alcohol and other drug use and abuse.

INPATIENT/RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT Treatment that takes place in a hospital or a related facility that requires an overnight stay. The duration of an inpatient's stay can be anything from one night to several depending on his/her condition, recovery requirements and recovery time.

MEDICAID A State and Federal program that helps with healthcare costs for some people with limited income and resources.

OUTPATIENT TREATMENT Treatment that takes place in facilities that are built to accommodate procedures that can be done during the day and which do not require an overnight stay.
