Upon completing a CTE program, students are prepared to:

- Enter college to further study a career pathway
- Enter the workforce with training aligned to industry standards
- Be career and college ready at the same time!

CTE Programs include opportunities for:

- Work-based learning experiences / internships
- Job shadowing
- Connections with area industry and higher ed partners
- College credits
- Mentorship that provides guidance on career exploration
- Membership in career-based organizations

- Most programs are two years and students typically participate in 11th and 12th grades; interested 9th graders may apply for Level I program placement in 10th grade.
- Students spend a half day at their home school completing their college prep academics and the other half day at their program school completing their CTE program.
- Students continue to participate in their home school athletics, clubs, activities and graduation.
- Transportation is provided.
