Career-Technical Education (CTE) provides students with relevant, engaging, hands-on programming that includes college-prep academics (English, math & science), technical skill development and career exploration.

Upon completing a CTE program, students are prepared to:

- Be career and college ready at the same time!
- Enter the workforce with training aligned to industry standards.
- Enter college to further study a career pathway.

CTE Programs include opportunities for:

- Work-based learning experiences / internships
- Job shadowing
- Connections with area industry and higher ed partners
- College credits
- Mentorship that provides guidance on career exploration
- Membership in career-based organizations

### What is the Compact?


The Six District Educational Compact is a network of six local school districts that offer 30 CTE programs to YOU!

- Most programs are two years, and students typically participate in 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Priority is given to placement in 11<sup>th</sup> grade, but rising 10<sup>th</sup> graders may still apply.
- Students spend a half day at their home school completing their college prep academics and the other half day at their program school completing their CTE program.
- Students continue to participate in their home school athletics, clubs, activities, and graduation.
- Transportation is provided.


