Through hands-on projects, work-based learning experiences, industry speakers, Business Professionals of America (BPA) competitions, and field trips, BSM students gain real-world skills and discover what it truly means to lead, innovate, and compete, both in the classroom and beyond.



Hands-on learning: field trips & work-based learning opportunities that inspire

BSM students take learning beyond the classroom with real-world experiences that prepare them for their future careers. Students have the opportunity to shadow professionals, gaining firsthand exposure to a variety of business and sports careers through work-based learning placements. Students visit the Pro Football Hall of Fame, where they explore event management and operations. A marketing workshop with the Cleveland Cavaliers allows students to learn how the team promotes games, engages fans, and manages sponsorships, followed by attending a live Cavs game to see those strategies in action. Students also attend Experience Business Days at local colleges, where they discover business programs and explore various career paths. These experiences give students authentic insight, professional connections, and inspiration for their future.

Students also participate in an accounting case study competition at Kent State University, a national social media marketing competition through BPA, and the Capitol Hill Challenge, an online stock market and personal finance competition that engages thousands of students nationwide.
