**Career Quest is a Career-Technical Education program offered through the Six District Educational Compact. This community-based job training program provides students with employment opportunities and authentic experiences aimed at increasing professional skills and career exploration.**

## WHO

Career Quest serves students with disabilities who have completed their graduation requirements, within Cuyahoga Falls, Hudson, Kent, Stow-Munroe Falls, Tallmadge, and Woodridge high schools.

## WHAT

Students participate in paid and unpaid internships at Kent State University and the surrounding communities, to gain the skills necessary for a successful transition from school to the workforce. The Job Training Coordinator facilitates planning activities and individualized support with the student and their family, school and adult service professionals, and employers.
